Cottage Chic Christmas

SPECIFICATIONS

Skill Level: Intermediate Quilt Size: 55" x 55" Block Size: 8" x 8" Number of Blocks: 25

This quilt is not just a Christmas quilt. Look beyond the season. It's a great opportunity to learn a new technique if you haven't tackled paper piecing yet.

MATERIALS

- ½ yard green tonal*
- 1/3 yard salmon dot tonal*
- ½ yard green dot tonal*
- 5/8 yard salmon trellis floral*
- · 1 yard salmon tonal*
- 11/8 yards green trellis floral*
- 11/4 yards salmon floral*
- 1¾ yards tan print*
- 3% yards backing
- Batting* 63" x 63"
- Thread*
- Basic sewing tools and supplies

*Lansdowne Road fabric collection from RJR Fabrics; Tuscany Silk batting from Hobbs; Aurifil Mako 50 cotton thread used to make sample.

CUTTING

Pieces cut for paper piecing do not have to be exact, but should be large enough to cover indicated area with at least 1/4" left over on each side.

From green tonal:

Cut 5 (1½" by fabric width) D/E strips.
 Trim 2 strips to 1½" x 40½" for D.

From salmon dot tonal:

 Cut 16 pieces to cover area 1 for paper piecing.

From green dot tonal:


 Cut 32 pieces to cover area 1 for paper piecing.

From salmon trellis floral:


• Cut 5 (31/4" by fabric width) F/G strips.

From salmon tonal:


- Cut 1 (25%" by fabric width) strip.
 Subcut into 13 (25%") A squares.
- Cut 48 pieces to cover areas 4 and 5 for paper piecing.




Green Star Cross 8" x 8" Block Make 8




Salmon Star Cross 8" x 8" Block Make 4




Cross 1 8" x 8" Block Make 4

From green trellis floral:

- Cut 1 (61/4" by fabric width) strip.
 Subcut into 4 (61/4") squares. Cut each square on both diagonals to make 16 C2 triangles.
- Cut 2 (3" by fabric width) strips.
 Subcut into 24 (3") squares. Cut each square in half on 1 diagonal to make 48 triangles to cover areas 6 and 7 for paper piecing.
- Cut 6 (2½" by fabric width) strips for binding.

From salmon floral:

- Cut 6 (31/4" by fabric width) J/K strips.
- Cut 2 (61/4" by fabric width) strips.
 Subcut into 9 (61/4") squares. Cut each square on both diagonals to make 36 C1 triangles.

From tan print:

- Cut 4 (6" by fabric width) strips.
 Subcut into 52 (25%" x 6")
 B rectangles.
- Cut 96 pieces to cover areas 2 and 3 for paper piecing.
- Cut 5 (1½" by fabric width) H/I strips.

COMPLETING THE STAR CROSS BLOCKS

1. Prepare paper-pieced sections for each block as directed on patterns

and referring to Figure 1 for color placement; trim excess beyond seam allowance on paper sections.



2. Select one each section 1 and 2, and join to make a half block as shown in Figure 2; repeat.



3. Join the two half blocks to complete one Green Star Cross block referring to Figure 3.



4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 to complete a total of eight Green Star Cross blocks and four Salmon Star Cross blocks.

COMPLETING THE CROSS BLOCKS

- **1.** Select one A and four each B and C1 pieces to complete one Cross 1 block.
- **2.** Sew B to opposite sides of A as shown in Figure 4; press seams toward A.

3. Sew C1 to opposite sides of B, matching the pieces at the square corners as shown in Figure 5; press seams toward C1.



4. Align a square ruler even with the edges of C1 and trim excess

B at corners to complete a C1-B unit as shown in Figure 6.

5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 to make a second C1-B unit. Sew a C1-B unit to opposite sides of the A-B unit, matching center seams as shown in Figure 7; press seams away from the A-B unit.



- **6.** Trim the B corners as in step 4 to complete one Cross 1 block.
- **7.** Repeat steps 1–6 to complete a total of 4 Cross 1 blocks.
- **8.** Repeat steps 2–6 to make four Cross 2 blocks using three C1 and one C2 triangle referring to Figure 8.




9. Repeat steps 2–6 to make four Cross 3 blocks using two each C1 and C2 triangles as shown in Figure 9.



10. Repeat steps 2–6 to make one Cross 4 block using four C2 triangles referring to Figure 10.




COMPLETING THE QUILT

- **1.** Referring to the Assembly Diagram, arrange and join the blocks in rows; press seams in adjacent rows in opposite directions.
- **2.** Join the rows as shown to complete the pieced center.
- **3.** Remove paper from the paper-pieced blocks.
- **4.** Sew D strips to opposite sides of the pieced center.
- **5.** Join E strips on short ends to make a long strip; subcut into two

- 1½" x 42½" E strips. Sew these strips to the top and bottom of the pieced center.
- **6.** Join the F/G strips on short ends to make a long strip; subcut into two 3½" x 42½" F strips and two 3½" x 48" G strips. Sew F strips to opposite sides and G strips to the top and bottom of the pieced center.
- 7. Repeat step 6 with H/I strips to subcut two each $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48" H and $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50" I strips; sew to the pieced center as in step 6.
- **8.** Repeat step 6 with J/K strips to subcut two each 3¼" x 50" J and 3¼" x 55½" K strips; sew to the pieced center as in step 6 to complete the quilt top.
- **9.** Create a quilt sandwich referring to Quilting Basics on page 94.
- 10. Quilt as desired.
- **11.** Bind referring to Quilting Basics on page 94 to finish. **QW**




Cottage Chic Christmas Assembly Diagram 55" x 55"
